For 15 years, the IA 50 has provided a publicly available database designed to help investors and advisors identify experienced impact fund managers across diverse impact areas and geographies.

An independent IA 50 Review Committee of 13 globally recognized industry leaders is responsible for the list's final selections. Their methodology follows a rigorous, multi-stage process that leverages both qualitative and quantitative analysis led by ImpactAssets Capital Partners. The IA 50 Review Committee makes the final selection, ensuring the analysis adheres to a structured framework of fairness, rigor and objectivity. All selected firms must demonstrate a track record in impact investing, clear impact objectives and U.S. investor accessibility. Inclusion on the IA 50 should not be viewed as an endorsement of RMS or any investment strategy.

"Across the IA 50, we see sustained investor commitment to affordability and economic development strategies that strengthen communities and expand access to opportunity," said Margret Trilli, CEO and CIO of ImpactAssets and ImpactAssets Capital Partners. "From affordable housing and community development to capital for small businesses and underrepresented entrepreneurs, these managers are directing capital where it can help build an inclusive economy while delivering competitive financial returns. That alignment between impact and performance is what continues to drive momentum in the market."

In 2025, three key initiatives illustrated RMS' commitment to impact investing:

- RMS and multiple partners negotiated four conservation easements to protect 62,000 acres of forestlands within the [Pee Dee Basin Initiative](#), culminating in one of the largest conservation land protection projects in South Carolina's history.

- RMS invested in rigorous biodiversity surveys to support proactive conservation planning, strengthen forest stewardship and inform investor reporting and stakeholder engagement.
- RMS played a key role in advancing landscape-scale species conservation, including the [reintroduction of a federally endangered species on private lands](#) and helping design voluntary agreements to secure incidental take assurance for threatened bat species.
